adaptive (adj.): capable of adapting

例句: Some animals are more <u>adaptive to</u> different climates than others.

3. strike (v.): to hit or attack

例句: Tsunami can <u>strike</u> any minute.

例句: He struck a chair with his fist. [struck= past tense of strike]

•strike (n.): an act of refusing to work as an act of protest

例句: The hotel workers' <u>strike</u> lasted for a week.
