1. port (n.): a place where ships load or unload.

例句: There are lots of restaurants near the port in downtown.

- seaport (n.): a coastal area in town where ships arrive

例句: The ship carrying a movie star arrives at the seaport today.

2. to dawn on (v.): begin to be understood

例句: It just dawned on him that he had saved enough money to buy a new laptop.

- dawn (n.): The time when daylight begins each morning.

例句: Running at dawn can be refreshing.

3. preserve (v.): to keep or maintain

例句: Preserve is not to be confused with conserve, which means to use sparingly in a wise way (e.g., to conserve energy).

- preservative (n.): a substance added to food to prevent it from undesirable chemical change

例句：Natural preservatives are added in some food to keep the food fresh and healthy for a longer period of time.

- preservation (n.): the act of preserving

例句：The food is kept in the refrigerator for better preservation.

4. spare (v.): to give or grant

例句: Can you spare some time for us?

- spare (adj.): available to use; something extra

例句: We should prepare a spare tire.

- spare (n.): a replacement; an extra thing

例句: This flashlight seems broken. Luckily, I've got a spare.
