1. We are really on top of this.

This means that we are really in control of the situation. In this context, May is referring to the fact that she and her teammates have pretty much figured out how to work on this project.

2. First act, then talk.
  - (1) After the division of labor is decided, Dean says this to encourage everyone to first go ahead and collect information before the whole team meets again to discuss how to put together the content everyone has found.
  - (2) Here, the imperative is used. Note that the subject, normally “you,” is omitted in the imperative, and the sentence begins with the base form of the verb. For example, “make yourself at home.”
