Grammar point & expression: 文法及用法

1. Give it a try

To give something a try or to give something a go means that one makes an attempt at something. For example, “I never ate raw fish before, but I’ll give it a try.”

2. Would you mind editing the text?

“Mind + V-ing” form is mostly used in negative statements and in questions. For example, “Harry doesn’t mind having lots of work” can mean “Having to do lots of work does not bother or upset Harry.” Consider also, for example, “Do you mind waiting for another 10 minutes?” as another way of saying, “Please wait for another 10 minutes” or, “I am afraid that you will have to wait for another 10 minutes.”
