• These photos are the best ones Cooper took in the photo contest <u>because</u> you're great at expressing feelings with your eyes.

解析: "<u>because you're great at expressing feelings with your eyes</u>" is a dependent clause. A dependent clause has a subject and a verb, but it does not include a complete thought. In this case, it cannot stand alone as a complete sentence. It is marked by a dependent marker. In this example, "because" is a dependent marker and the part introduced by it is thus called a dependent clause.
