例句: Hide (獸皮) used as a noun means a piece of animal skin.

例句:A hideout (藏身處) is a place where one goes to hide.

例句: <u>Hide-and-seek</u> (捉迷藏) is a game children play, where all the children find a place to <u>hide</u> except one, called the "It," who must find everyone.

2. heavens (n.): an English equivalent for "上天"

例句: I thank the <u>heavens</u> everyday for suffering no injury in that horrible car accident.

例句: We stared up at the heavens trying to see the star.

If the heavens open, it suddenly starts to rain a lot.

例句: As soon as we got to the park, the heavens opened.

thank heavens/God/goodness: to express happiness that something has been avoided or has finished, but religiously inclined believers may say, "Thank the Lord," or "Thank God" instead.

例句: <u>Thank heavens</u> the weather this weekend is so beautiful.

3. guess (n.): an informal equivalent for "think"

例句: I guess I did alright in my speech, but I'm not really sure.

例句: If you don't know the answer, take a guess.

例句: They are just my wild guesses (= ones which were made without much thought).
