1. hide (v.): to remain out of sight; to seek protection or evade responsibility

例句：He can't hide behind his parents forever.

例句：Hide (獸皮) used as a noun means a piece of animal skin.

例句：A hideout (藏身處) is a place where one goes to hide.

例句：Hide-and-seek (捉迷藏) is a game children play, where all the children find a place to hide except one, called the “It,” who must find everyone.

2. heavens (n.): an English equivalent for “上天”

例句：I thank the heavens everyday for suffering no injury in that horrible car accident.

the heavens: the sky

例句：We stared up at the heavens trying to see the star.

If the heavens open, it suddenly starts to rain a lot.

例句：As soon as we got to the park, the heavens opened.

thank heavens/God/goodness: to express happiness that something has been avoided or has finished, but religiously inclined believers may say, “Thank the Lord,” or “Thank God” instead.

例句：Thank heavens the weather this weekend is so beautiful.

3. guess (n.): an informal equivalent for “think”

例句: I guess I did alright in my speech, but I'm not really sure.

guess (n.): an attempt to give an answer when you are not sure if you are correct

例句: If you don't know the answer, take a guess.

例句: They are just my wild guesses (= ones which were made without much thought).
