- 1) A gift is a present. It is something given to someone voluntarily and without expecting to receive something in return.

- 2) To have a gift (for something) means to have a talent (for something).
 - 例句: My friend Denise has a gift for singing; she sings very well.

When used in computers, multimedia refers to a type of information that includes text, audio, video, and sometimes animation. Multimedia is commonly used in advertisements, entertainment, and education, among others. For instance, the Flash videos that one sees on almost every web page, or the special effects in movies such as *Avatar*, or the animation that you see in this E-plan website, along with the audio, are a type of multimedia.

例句: With the advent of broadband, one can easily download <u>multimedia</u> from the Internet and play it on one's computer.

例句: Interactive multimedia now plays a major role in children's education.

2) A multimedia presentation is a type of presentation that contains some form of animation or a combination of animation, sound, and video or movie clip.

例句:The teacher gave Mary high marks for her convincing <u>multimedia</u> <u>presentation</u>.
