Cooper: Who brought you here to this school?

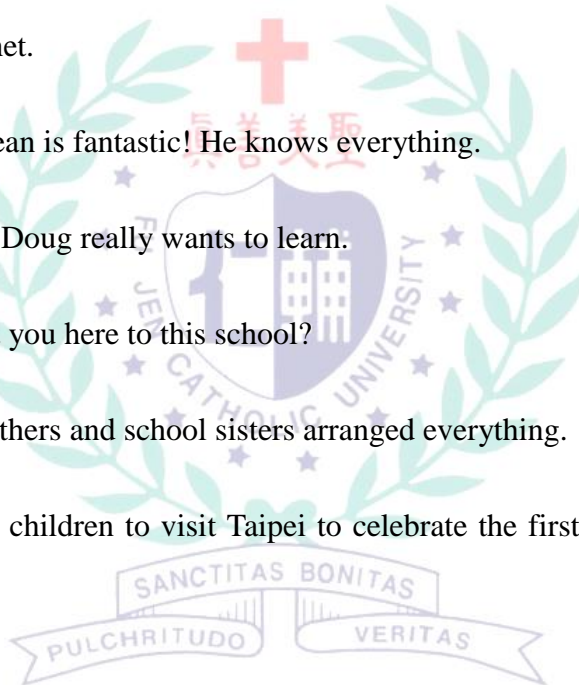
Doug: The school brothers and school sisters arranged everything.
