1. Let me take a look

解析: If a person takes a look at something, he's looking at it carefully.

If you ask your friend to "take a look at yourself in the mirror," you are asking your friend to examine himself and reflect on his performance.

Asking someone "to take a look" at something means you want that person to turn his attention to what you are pointing at.

例句: You could say "Take a look at these flowers" or "Take a look at that new car" if you want to start a conversation about the flowers or the new car that you are referring to.

2. Even

解析: "Even" is used to add emphasis or to suggest an extreme case.

例句: (On the Internet) I even ask for advice on my teaching materials.

"I *even* ask for advice on my teaching materials" suggests that asking for advice is among the many things that the speaker uses the Internet to do. It suggests that it is not everyday that someone asks for advice on teaching materials on the Internet.

例句: Because business is slow, many stores stay open for longer hours just to attract more business. Some stores stay open *even* until midnight.
