Cooper: Really? Who taught you all this?

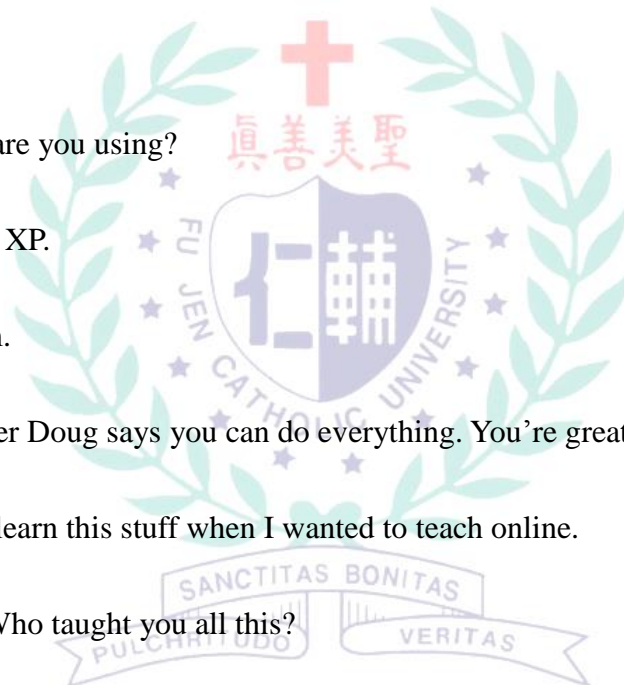
Dean: I taught myself. When I have questions or problems, I just ask people on the Internet.
