1. abundance (n.): a great amount

例句: Our harvests are in <u>abundance</u> this fall.

abundant (adj.)	abundance (n.)	

Abundant is the adjective form of abundance,

例句: There used to be an <u>abundant</u> supply of water in this region, but now all the wells nearby are dried up.

2. astrological (adj .): of the study of the positions and aspects of celestial bodies in the belief that they have an influence on the course of natural earthly occurrences and human affairs.

例句: What is your <u>astrological</u> sign? Mine is Virgo.

astrology (n.)	astrological (adj.)	
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Note: **Astrology** (占星) is not the same as **astronomy** (the study of matter in outer space).

3. prosperity (n.): the condition of being successful or wealthy

例句: May you have prosperity in the years to come.

prosperous (adj.)	prosperity (n.)	prosper (v.)

prosperous, (adj.): doing very well in life, and having many comforts in life.

例句: This used to be a <u>prosperous</u> town.

to prosper (v.): to be fortunate or successful

例句: When you begin to <u>prosper</u>, it is a good time to start saving up and counting your blessings, lest you begin to waste what you have and eventually lose everything.

4. auspicious (adj.): favourable, marked for success, having good luck

例句: The four-leafed clover and rabbit's foot are both <u>auspicious</u> charms for you to keep.

under the auspices of		
auspice (n.)	auspicious (adj.)	
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auspice (n.) an omen; protection or support

Auspice is rarely ever used on its own. Rather, when we use this word, we almost always use the phrase "under the auspices of."

例句: Under the auspices of the new harvest moon, the two lovers pledged their undying devotion to each other.
