- present (n.): gift

例句：I bought a present for your birthday.

- at present (n): right now

例句：At present, I am preparing for my final exam.

- presentation (n.): the act of giving information in a formal and structured way to a group of people

例句：The presentation by our classmate was very interesting.

- present (adj.): to be here

例句：Everyone is present in this class.

- presently (adv.): now

The teacher is presently out of his office.

information (n.): knowledge about facts

例句：There is a lot of information on the Internet.
