

## 2. 文法

“Should” is a modal verb, which is an auxiliary verb used:

1. to give advice

例句：You should pay more attention in class.

2. to give recommendation

例句：You should ask the teacher to give you more time to write your term paper.

3. to indicate obligation

例句：You should turn off the lights and lock the door when you leave. You should fasten your seatbelt while in the car.

4. to indicate expectation

例句：I figure Cooper and May should be here soon. The sentence means that Cooper and May aren't here yet, but I expect them to be arriving anytime soon.

5. to express an opinion. In this case, it is weaker and more personal than “must” or “have to”

例句：I think you should just resign from your job if you're really unhappy.

Please note in the above examples that “should” is fixed; there is only one form of “should.” Also, the main verb is always in the infinitive.
