2. 文法

"Should" is a model verb, which is an auxiliary verb used:

- 1. to give advice
 - 例句: You should pay more attention in class.
- 2. to give recommendation
 - 例句: You should ask the teacher to give you more time to write your term paper.
- 3. to indicate obligation
 - 例句:You <u>should</u> turn off the lights and lock the door when you leave. You <u>should</u> fasten your seatbelt while in the car.
- 4. to indicate expectation
 - 例句:I figure Cooper and May <u>should</u> be here soon. The sentence means that Cooper and May aren't here yet, but I expect them to be arriving anytime soon.
- 5. to express an opinion. In this case, it is weaker and more personal than "must" or "have to"
 - 例句:I think you should just resign from your job if you're really unhappy.

Please note in the above examples that "should" is fixed; there is only one form of "should." Also, the main verb is always in the infinitive.
