例句:The <u>fertile</u> soil is essential for growing nutritious vegetables.

• fertility (n.): ability to produce offspring; capacity of soil to grow plants

fertilize (v.): to make fertile

例句: Some farmers teach students ways to fertilize the soil in the agricultural class.

• fertilizer (n.): a substance spread on the land or plants to make plants grow well

例句: The farmer uses organic fertilizer on his vegetables.
